**(for SAA appointments at 50% FTE or higher)**

Note: SAA graduate student appointees are entitled to fee remission per the SAA handbook. There are no restrictions on the SAA as to what courses can be taken per that policy. However, the College and OVPR will only provide the out of state portion of the fee remission for courses taken in the College by College graduate students (unless prior approval for hiring a non-College student - see College fee remission guidelines for details). The department or center may be responsible for all credit hours taken outside the College.

Previous health insurance increases:

2005-06 - \$1,007

2006-07 - \$1,365 = \$358 or 35.55% inc from 05/06

2007-08 - \$1,553 = \$188 or 13.77% inc from 06/07

2008-09 - \$1,913 = \$360 or 23.18% inc from 07-08

2009-10 - \$2,076 = \$163 or 8.52% inc from 08-09

2010-11 - \$2,278 = \$202 or 9.7% increase from 09-10

2011-12 - \$2,414 = \$136 or 5.98% increase from 10-11
